All members enjoyed hand-made dishes prepared by volunteers after playing Balloon art, Japanese languages games in divided groups and concentration (playing-cards). 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No need to pay out-of-pocket medical cost at the reception of medical institutions When children in elementary and middle school have medical checkups in Fujimi, Fujimino city and Miyoshi town, it is unnecessary to pay out-of-pocket medical cost at reception from Oct., same as children preschool age and younger. The children eligible are infant aged 0 up to the third grade of junior high school. The new certificate will be sent on September end by post mail.

Please apply for registration as soon as possible if you do not have it. It is unavailable to have free clinic without this certificate. When you fail to take the certificate to the medical institutions, please apply for the refund to the municipal office by the $10^{\rm th}$ of next month with receipt after paying out-of-pocket medical cost at reception.

Emergency call 119 with interpreter service starts in Saitama City.

FICEC have been providing the interpreter service in consultation between municipal offices and FICEC via mobile phone and this system is now available in Higashi-Matsuyama, Warabi, Misato City and Namegawa Town. We have been making effort to take further development expansion of this activity. In relating to this, the Fire Bureau in Saitama city starts emergency call, 119 with interpreter service which is slightly different from FICEC's one. Languages: English, Chinese, Korean, Spanish and Portuguese. It is open 24 hours a day. It is the first attempt in the government-ordinance-designated cities in Japan and a lot of people are

The foreign residents are subject to the Basic Resident Registration Law, same as Japanese nationals. The municipal office sent "Provisional resident record". The "Provisional resident record" will become authoritative from July 9 and it is possible to get the copy of all family members in Basic Resident Registration.

Let's have double locks in your bicycle.

Each city in Saitama Prefecture alerts citizens to pay attention to high-theft bicycle. One of the most high-theft items is bicycle throughout city. Some of you have experienced that you found your bicycle stolen after putting your bicycles at bicycle-parking lot for short time when coming back to the lot. Please note that it is a distinct crime if you use others' bicycle without permission. Let's take appropriate countermeasures against bicycle theft in advance. It becomes common-sense to have double locks in your bicycle when parking your bicycle. In August issue, we will introduce "How to ride a bicycle" which is interesting to pedestrians.

Did you submit the explanation sheet?

The Child Care Allowance was changed to the Child Allowance together with their system on April 2012. In relating to this change, it is necessary to submit the explanation sheet in fiscal year 2012 to the municipal office. The sheet is sent to each family in middle of June. Please submit it to the municipal office by July 20(Sat). If you fail to submit it, you may not receive the Child Allowance.
