# “National census”



Japan's most important statistical survey “Census” will be held. The census covers all people who normally live in Japan, regardless of nationality and the answers are required.

It is the important survey to find out how many people live in Japan and used to realize a community that is easy for foreigners to live in too. Be sure to answer it.

## ■ Survey flow

- In September, you will receive an envelope containing the document “Request for Census” at your home. There is an explanation about how to answer on the front side of the envelope so please read and answer it.

## How to answer [Internet or mail] [Deadline October 7]

(1) Answers on the Internet are very convenient (September 14 to October 7)

Life counseling

FICEC offers life counseling from 10:00 to 16:00, from Monday to Friday.



We are foreigners couple and a child is born. How will be the baby's visa?

Go to the nearest city hall and submit a birth registration within 14 days. Obtain a birth registration acceptance certificate from the city hall. Go to the embassy or consulate of your country, submit your acceptance certificate and apply for a passport.

Go to the Immigration Bureau within 30 days and apply for permission to obtain a status of residence. Documents required at that time are a birth registration acceptance certificate, parents' residence card, residence tax payment certificate, employment certificate, resident card with all household heads, and the baby's passport.

You do not need to apply for a visa if you will return to your country within 60 days.

I'm in trouble because my income has decreased due to the effects of corona. I heard that the Social Welfare Council will give us 600,000 yen.

There are many people coming to apply for the special loan for the General Support Fund of the Social Welfare Council. This is a loan that is deferred for 3 months and then should return in installments.

Don't forget the obligation to return. FICEC is an NPO that supports only those who obey the law and adhere to their obligations.
