



How to make a bank account



A foreigner came to our office and asked “I have been in Japan for 5 months. I want to make a cash card.”

Here is how to make a bank account at a cash teller near your house. You can also make your bank account by online registration.

Necessary procedures and documents to make a bank account at a cash teller

If you are a temporary visitor (within 90 days) you cannot make a bank account in Japan. Even if you have a long-term stay visa (more than 90 days), you cannot make a bank account if you have not been in Japan for more than 6 months. If you have stayed in Japan for 6 months or more and have a resident card you can make a bank account so that you can make a remittance. If you have not been in Japan for more than 6 months, your bank account is not able to make a remittance. In that case you can only receive your salary and receive remittance from overseas. It takes for 2 weeks to make a cash card. (It differs according to the bank account.)

■ Necessary procedure

- The said person should make procedure at the bank teller
- The said person should fill in the procedure documents. (Fill in kana pronouncing in katakana.)
- It takes about 1 or 2 weeks to open a bank account, which may differ according to each bank. In some case you can open a bank account in about 30 minutes at a bank teller.

■ Necessary document

- ◆ Passport ◆ Resident card ◆ Certification to indicate expiration date of the visa card
- ◆ Address of Japan (Address where the mails reach to you) ◆ Telephone number (mobile phone number may do) ◆ Driver's license in Japan ◆ My number ◆ Signature stamp (Signature may do for foreigners in some cases)
- ◆ In some case, usage details of public utility charge, copy of resident card, insurance card may be necessary according to banks.

There are many banks in Fujimi-shi, Fujimino-shi and Miyoshi-machi

If you are going to make a bank account at a bank branch far from where you live, you should explain the reason or you may be turned down in some cases. It may be easier to make procedure at your nearest branch.

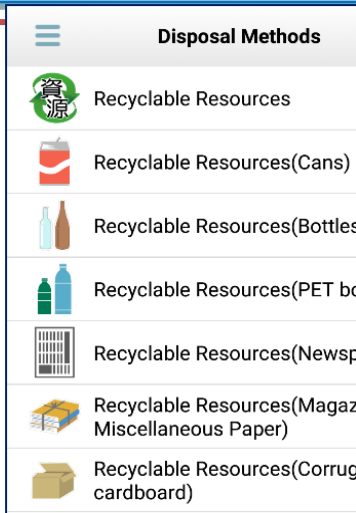
